South Central Public Lands Study

- Chisholm Public School, 165 Charnwood Dr.
- Linbrook Public School, 1079 Linbrook Rd.
- Brantwood Public School, 221 Allan St.
- Oakville-Trafalgar Memorial Hospital (OTMH), 327 Reynolds St.

The preferred land use options to be provided at the open house are based on public feedback as well as a detailed technical evaluation and financial analysis of the preliminary land use options by town staff and the study consultants.

The purpose of the South Central Public Lands Study is to define a preferred land use option for each of the study sites. The town owns the Linbrook, Brantwood and Chisholm school sites, and will acquire the Reynolds Street OTMH site when the new hospital opens.

A final report is scheduled to be presented to Town Council on Monday, March 18, 2013 at 7 p.m. in the Council Chamber at Town Hall, 1225 Trafalgar Road.
