We would like to thank all of you for your patience and cooperation and hope this email finds you safe and healthy.

Provincial cases continue to increase and a quick end to this pandemic remains unlikely. We need to flatten the curve. Ongoing physical distancing and avoidance of group gatherings is imperative.

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic the Town of Oakville has implemented preventative measures to protect you and our community, to reduce the spread of the virus.

**The Town of Oakville is extending the closure of the Harbour office, storage yards, and launch ramp facilities until further notice. At this time launch dates are still not known. All Town Parks and Facilities remain closed until further notice. This is a very fluid situation so please monitor your email for important updates.**

**Due to the uncertainty of the situation we are not leasing any mooring slips to new customers at this time but are accepting wait-list customers. Refunds for moorings will be considered and those wishing to submit please send a request by email to Amy Johnson – Harbours Administrator at [amy.johnson@oakville.ca](mailto:amy.johnson@oakville.ca) Customers are asked to please be patient as refunds will be processed at a later date in May.**

Harbours administration is still working remotely receiving launch applications electronically and maintaining launch schedules.

Storage inspections are still in effect. For security reasons staff will remove any ladders that are not locked securely. For fire safety, any vessel plugged into to hydro, will be unplugged.
