

## 2018 Picnic Area User Guide

Take advantage of the beautiful parks in the Town of Oakville to plan your next family, organization or company picnic. Designated picnic areas in Lions Valley Park and Coronation Park include picnic tables and a barbeque pit. All organized gatherings in municipal parks require a permit.

**NEW 2018: Any group with more than 100 persons, or requiring additional services; alcohol, catered food, sales, inflatables, animals, etc. must be applied for as a [Special Event](#) as additional requirements, fees and approvals are required.**

### Picnic Online Availability Search

2. Select Type "Parks – Picnic" and date time parameters to conduct a search
3. To request times, complete the request form and submit it for processing

**Note: 2018 Bookings at Coronation Park were made available to book as of May 1, 2018 removing the 45 day booking restriction that had been implemented due to flooding assessment. Picnic Area 1 will remain closed for the season due to construction, sites 2 to 5 are available for booking.**

### Permit Conditions

- All permits require \$2 million dollars liability insurance naming the "Town of Oakville" as "an additional insured. Proof of insurance can be provided, or coverage can be added to the permit.
- Permits must be signed to be confirmed. Payment must be provided in full upon confirmation.
- Cancellations must be made 14 days in advance of any booking, or full charges apply.
- Any third party vendors/businesses must be approved in advance and provide \$2 million liability insurance naming the Town of Oakville as additional insured. This would include any organization, groups or companies who are providing a service, or goods for your event including photographers, face painting, clowns, etc.

**Lions Valley Park – 1227 Lions Valley Road**

Located on Dundas Street near Fourth Line. Two large designated sheltered picnic areas with a barbeque pit, a playground and plenty of open space and seasonal portable washrooms. There is no hydro at this park.

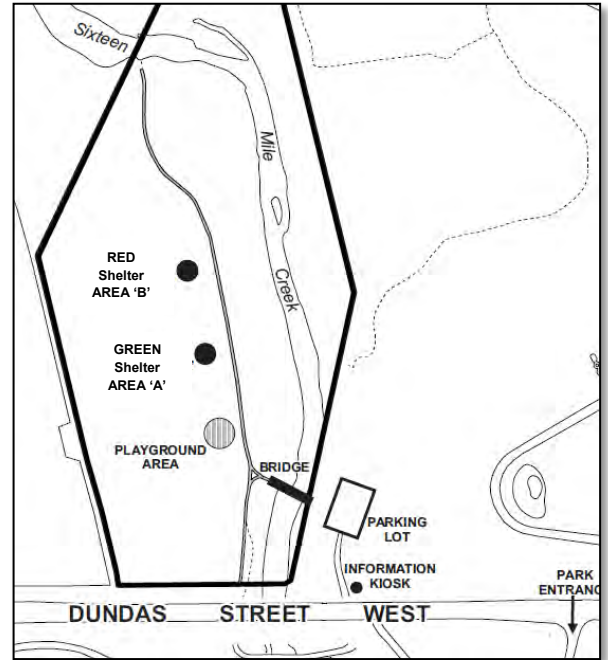

**Red Shelter - Picnic Area B**

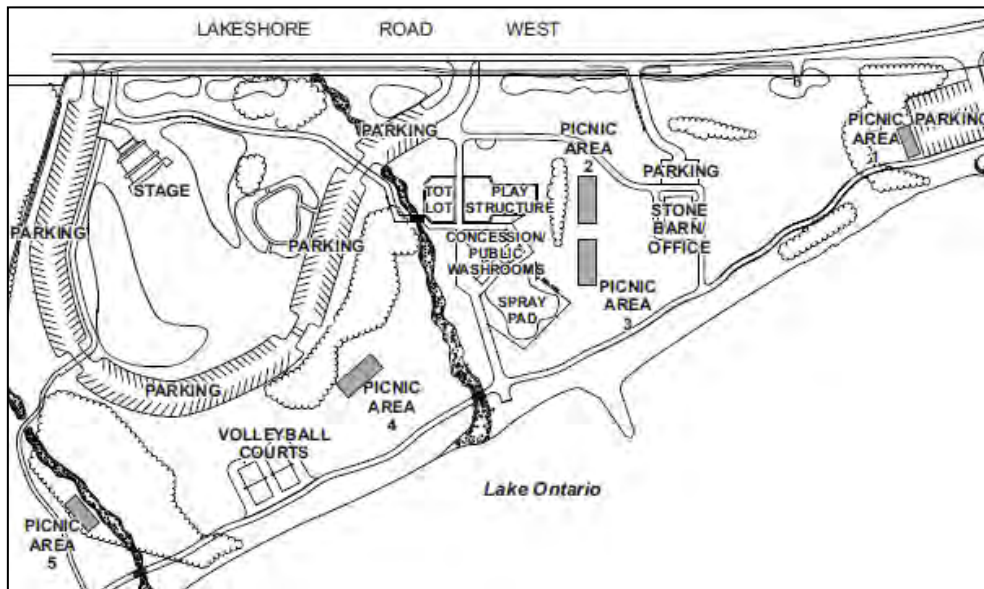
BBQ and 10 Picnic Tables

**Coronation Park – 1426 Lakeshore Road West**

Located on Lake Ontario, just east of Third Line. Five large designated picnic areas, each with a barbecue pit. Amenities in the park include public washrooms, fully accessible playground, splash pad and a concession stand. Hydro access can be permitted at shelters areas 2, 3, 4.

BBQ pit, 8 Picnic Tables  
Up to 80 persons

**Park Restrictions**

- Bring charcoal for the BBQ pits, it is the only type of BBQ allowed. Personal barbeques are not permitted on any municipal parkland, and parks are patrolled.
- Alcoholic beverages are strictly prohibited.

- Concession contracts are in place at Coronation Park. No catered food service is permitted in this location without written permission from the Parks Department.
