

Studio Memberships

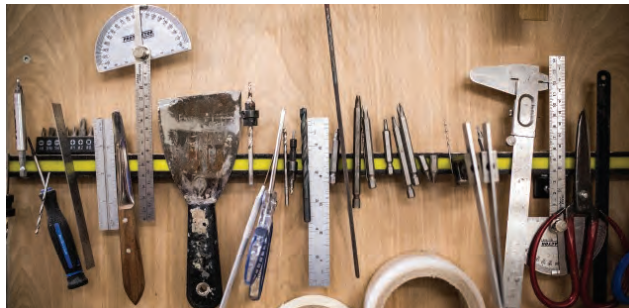
- The QEPCCC Studio Membership is geared towards artists who are able to work without instruction. Members are expected to exhibit a good understanding of the materials, tools and processes required to safely practice independently in our specialized studios.
- Individual/Artist memberships are available monthly for only \$40 +HST. A non-resident fee of \$10 +HST will be charged as applicable. Please note there are no discounts available on this membership.
- QEPCCC Guild members may purchase a monthly membership for \$26 +HST. A non-resident fee of \$10 +HST will be charged as applicable.
- Members get access to all participating QEPCCC studios but must choose one as a home base. Access is Monday to Thursday from 8 a.m. to 10 p.m., Fridays from 8 a.m. to 9 p.m., and on weekends from 8 a.m. to 7 p.m. when there are no programmed classes or bookings. Studio schedules and availability can be found at active.oakville.ca.
- Members must be 18 years+. No visitors allowed in the studios.
- Members must sign-in at customer service.
- Members must show demonstrated ability and prerequisite courses for access to specialized studio equipment (i.e. wood working, digital ceramics).
- Members are responsible for cleaning the studio space after use.
- One half-locker is provided. See front desk to register one under your name.
- One free open shelf is assigned for storing materials in some designated studios only. Subject to availability.
- Additional locker rental is available for rent by members on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Additional storage shelves (open) in the wood working studio, ceramics studio and fine art studio can be purchased subject to availability.
- Individuals interested in becoming a monthly member must meet with the appropriate technician or studio assistant.

Drop-In Studio Time

Two drop-in options are available:

- \$11.50 drop-in fee plus additional material fees in clay studio.
- A family rate is \$9.10 per participant for All-Ages Family drop-in times. Children up to 13 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.
- A non-resident fee of \$10 +HST will be charged as applicable.
- Technician will be on site in the wood working studio and ceramic studio.
- Non-structured creative time to make work, not a formal class led by an instructor.
- Offered approximately 12 hours a week in each studio (wood working, ceramic, fine arts, digital arts and textiles).
- Individuals interested in accessing Drop-in Studio times must meet with the appropriate technician or studio assistant (not required for all-ages drop-in).
- Participants must be 18+. No visitors allowed in studios.

Note: Drop-in times will not be available during scheduled PA Days and camp programs. Please check active.oakville.ca for the current studio drop-in schedule.



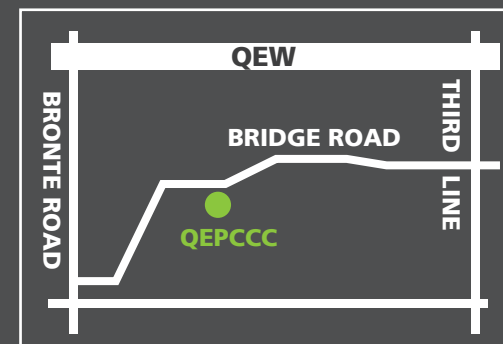

Studio details and descriptions

Ceramic Studio

- Cone 6 clay only. Purchase from technician. \$35 per bag/\$5 per piece during drop-in. Clay fee includes glazes and firings.
- Selection of studio glazes.
- Two-hour pre-registered studio safety workshop with technician is required (fee applies)
- Kilns fired by the technician. Member work fired after QECC program pieces and when kiln full.
- Equipment includes: wheels, slab roller, and electric kilns.



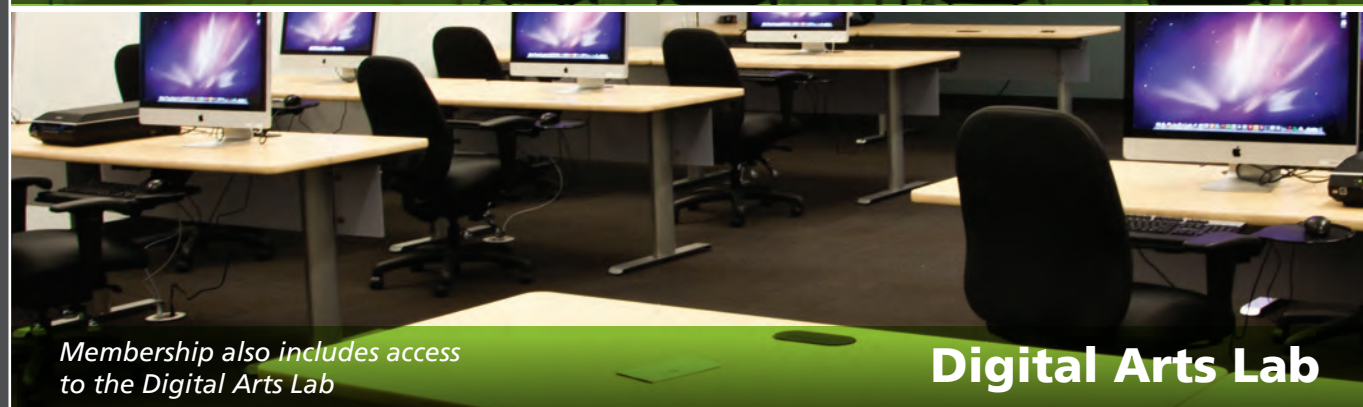
Wood Working Studio

- Two-hour pre-registered shop safety workshop with the technician and successful completion of shop safety test required (fee applies).
- Projects reviewed by technician to assess appropriateness, materials, equipment and storage.
- Heavy machinery available during drop-in studio times only.
- Stationary machines include: table saw, bandsaw, drill press, lathe, mini lathe, hollow chisel mortiser, spindle sander, edge sander, mitre saw, scroll saw, router table and down draft table.



Fine Arts Studio

- All work areas shared in this open studio.
- Accommodates sculpture, drawing and painting with water colours, acrylics and water-based oils only.
- Works in progress only. No storage of finished artwork.
- Access to tables, chairs, stools, easels, slop sink, turning sculpture stands, drying racks and Wi-Fi.
- Materials not included.
