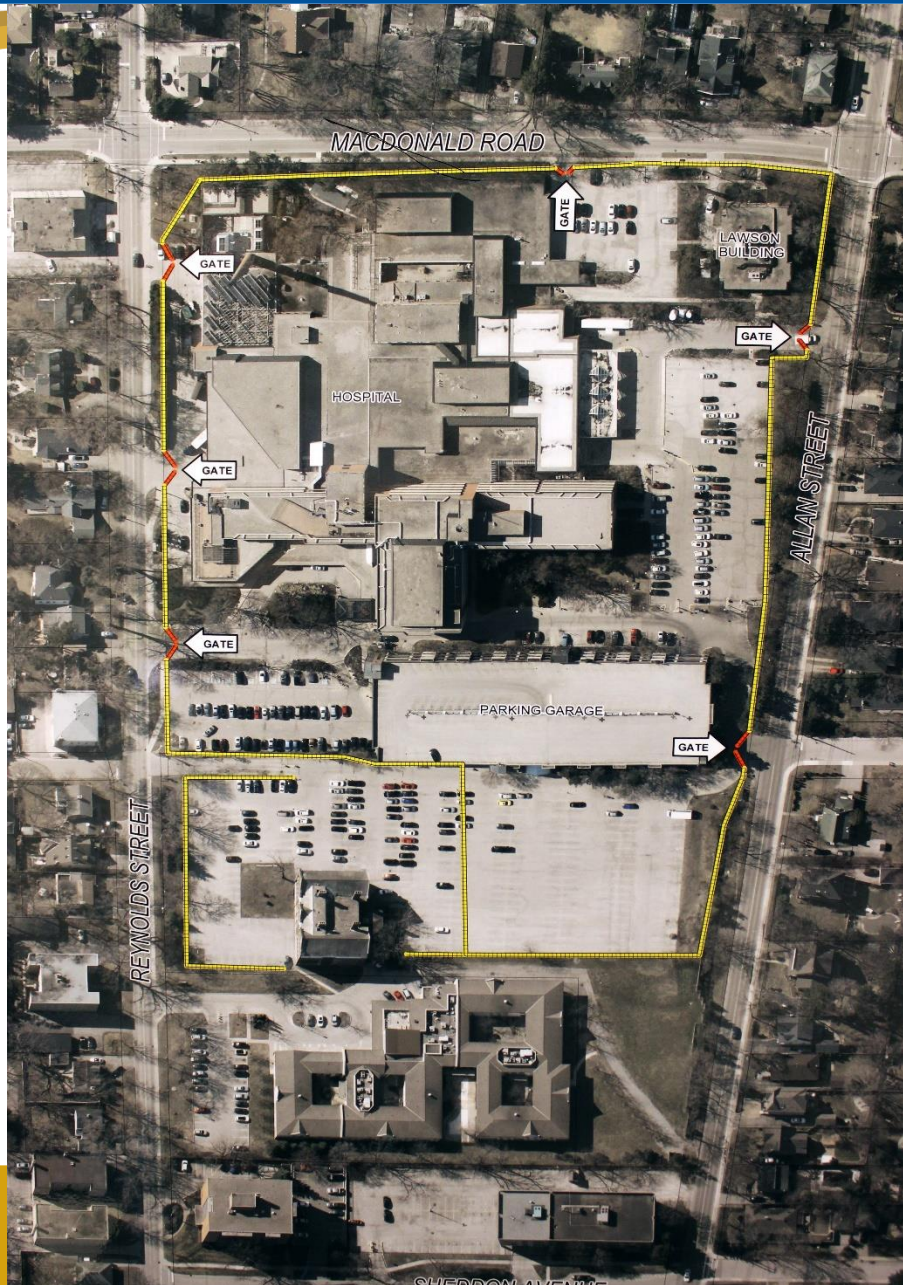

- Parks, Recreation, Culture and Library Master Plan to be completed and presented in Council with the South East Oakville Community Centre report in spring, 2017

“What We’ve Heard”

- More than 400 contributions and 700 Recommendations
- Information from Public Consultation, Public Open House, Email and Website submissions
- Information categorized into 5 key areas
- Facility Amenities, Programming, Fitness, Parks and Open Space and Aquatic Centre

Oakville Trafalgar High School

- Designated as a heritage property in 1994
- The manner in which the property will be incorporated into the site is being studied



Facility Amenities

- Large, Accessible Community Rooms for Multi-Purpose Use
- Gymnasium
- Fitness Centre
- Aquatic Centre
- First Nations Space
- Potential Older Adult and Youth Space
- Use of natural light, comfortable seating and spaces to socialize
- Other : Library, Sauna, Free Parking

Programming

- Intergenerational Programming to meet the needs of all age categories
- Yoga, Tai-Chi, Pilates
- Arts and Culture
- Children's Programming
- Badminton, Pickle-Ball
- Walking Track
- Accessible and Inclusive Programming

Fitness Centre

- Cardio Equipment
- Weight Resistance Equipment
- Tai-Chi
- Pilates
- Yoga
- Aerobic Classes
- Kid Fit



Parks and Open Space

- Significant Support for Green Space
- Outdoor “Community Space” or “Bumping Space”
 - Play Structure
 - Splash Pad
 - Community Event Space
- Other Potential Amenities
 - Outdoor Ice Rink
 - Skateboard Park
 - Community Garden

South East Community Centre: Design should consider an indoor pool(Centennial Pool replacement), gymnasium, youth space, active living space, multi-purpose space and community rooms. Senior's programming may also be considered, however, the focus for dedicated space for seniors should remain along Kerr Street corridor and is not recommended for the OTMH site. Through the South Central Lands Study, the availability and suitability of potential sites will be evaluated, examining various combinations of components.
