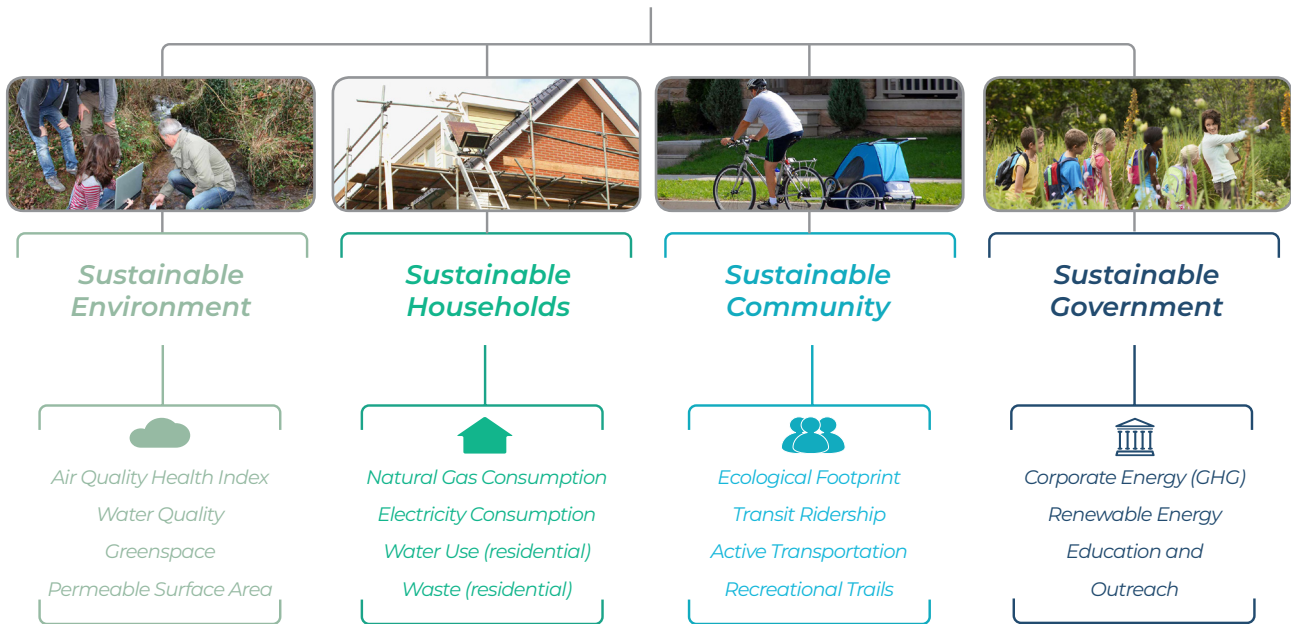

TRACKING SOER INDICATORS

The town’s Environmental Sustainability Plan (ESP) provides an overarching framework for the town’s environmental sustainability efforts. Oakville’s State of the Environment Report (SOER) is a companion program to the ESP that tracks selected indicators that provide a snapshot of how we are doing on environmental sustainability, a key factor in being a “livable town”.

A livable town has:

- Clean air and water
- Sufficient greenspace to support a healthy environment
- Access to public transit and active transportation
- A small ecological footprint
- Public leadership and citizens committed to reducing our impact on the environment.

The SOER program is the foundation of a framework to track and report on progress toward achieving environmental goals and priorities with the understanding that “what gets measured, gets managed”. The indicators illustrate whether things are going well, and if not, identify which areas require more attention. 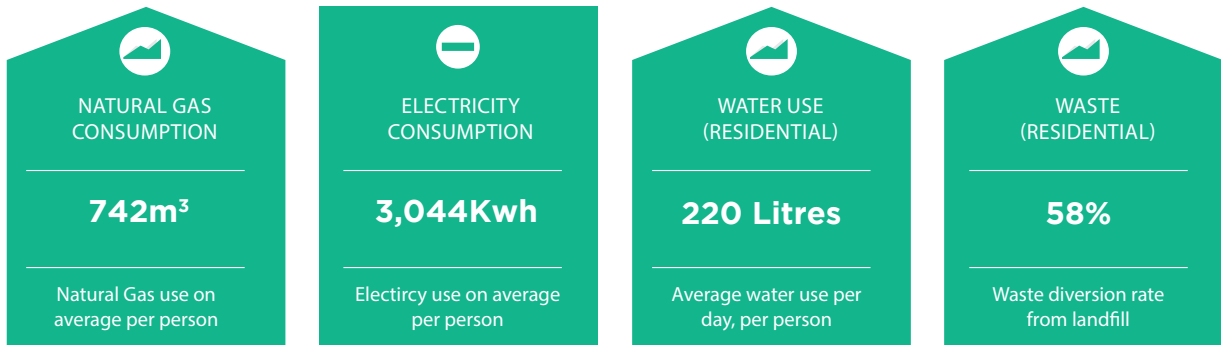

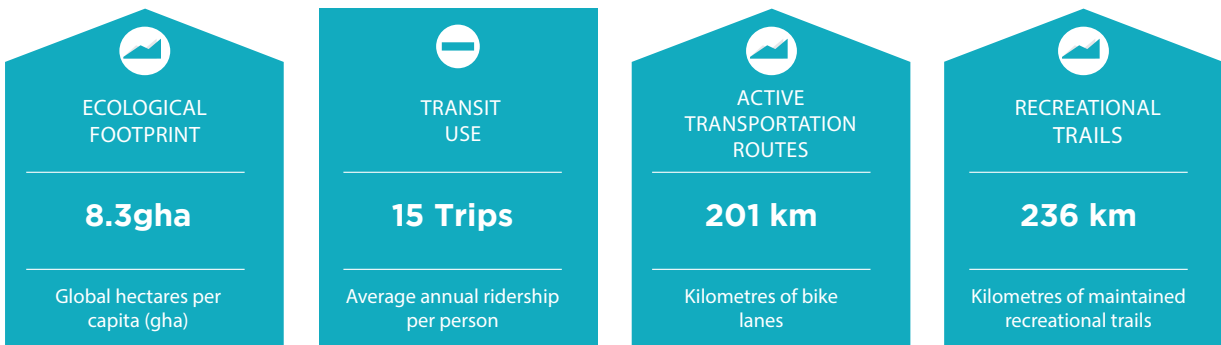
