The Town of Oakville appreciates your feedback and ideas and we encourage you to get involved.

At the open house, you have an opportunity to learn about this study — what area it covers, why it is being done, concerns being addressed and a look at opportunities. We will also ask you for your input on what recommendations you might have for the study area. The project study team will be available to answer your questions and take your comments. A second open house will be held in the spring for final public input.

What is the purpose of this study?

The Town of Oakville is undertaking an Area Wide Transportation Study to examine various transportation issues in the College Park neighbourhood. Concerns around traffic congestion, vehicle speeds and public safety have previously been raised in the study area that has led the town to undertake this study.

The study area, as shown below, includes a specific focus on the intersection of Sixth Line and McCraney Street while also focusing on transportation issues around the various schools in the study area. The study area does not include Sheridan College, the Oakville Place shopping centre, or roads under the jurisdiction of Halton Region (e.g., Trafalgar Road, Upper Middle Road, South Service Road).

Staff invite you to share your views on any transportation issue facing the neighbourhood. Two Public Information Centres (PICs) are planned to obtain public input on the Transportation Study. The first PIC is designed to hear from you on what you consider to be transportation problems within the neighbourhood. We invite you to attend the first PIC on:
