The study includes a specific focus on the intersection of Sixth Line and McCraney Street while also focusing on transportation issues around the various schools in the study area. The study area does not include Sheridan College, the Oakville Place shopping centre, or roads under the jurisdiction of Halton Region (e.g., Trafalgar Road, Upper Middle Road, South Service Road).
