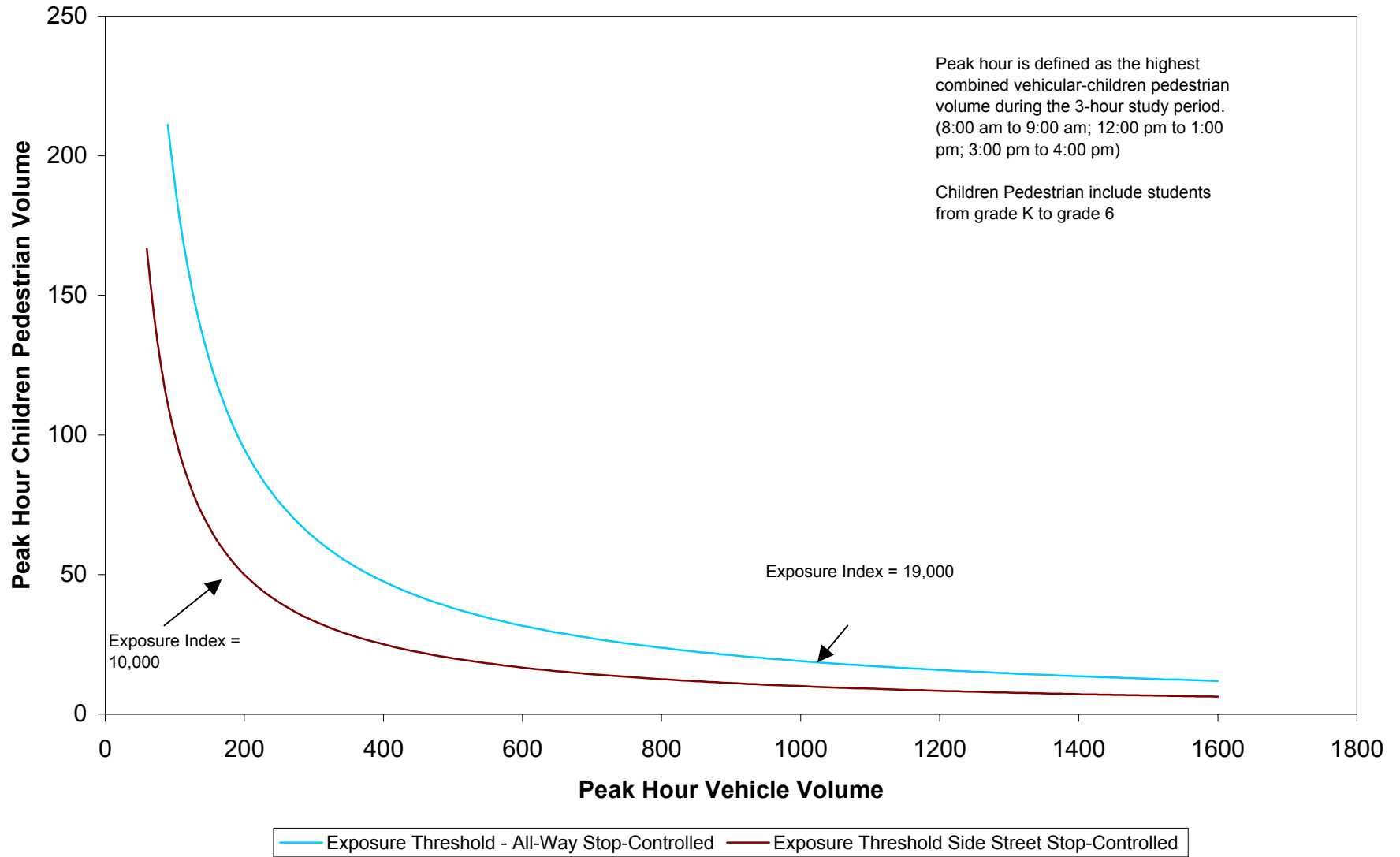

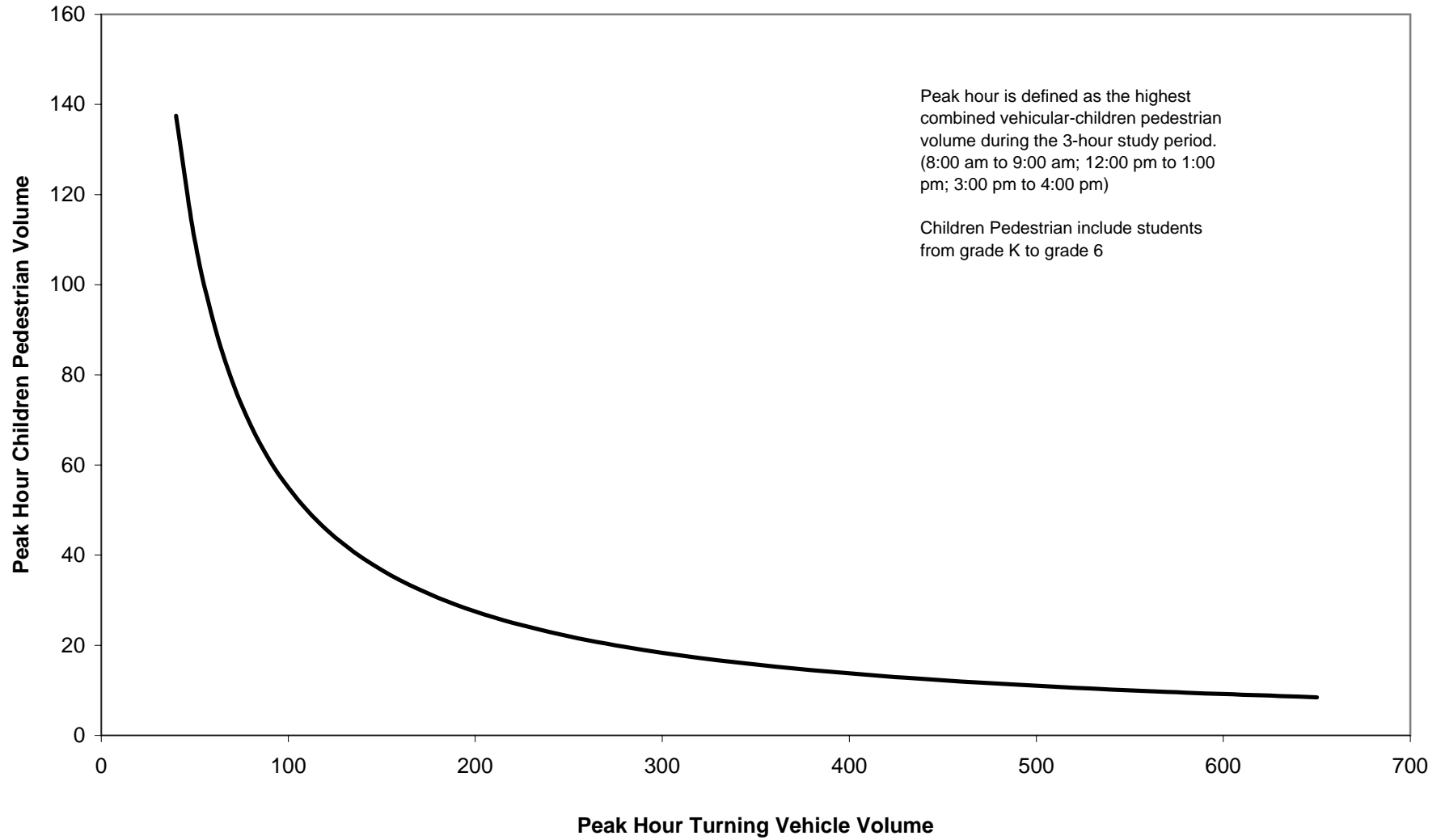
Consideration of a School Crossing Guard will not be given to locations with an average speed of 60 km/h or more and a level of 15000 vpd.
