

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF OAKVILLE

BY-LAW NUMBER 2016-109

A by-law to re-divide, alter and increase the number of wards in the Town of Oakville.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Oakville is authorized by subsection 222(1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001* to divide or re-divide the town into wards or to dissolve existing wards.

COUNCIL ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the existing six (6) wards are hereby re-divided into seven (7) wards in accordance with Schedule “A” to this by-law and as described in detail in Schedule “B” to this by-law.
2. Schedules “A” and “B” attached hereto form part of this by-law.
3. That each ward shall be represented by two Councillors, one of whom shall also be a member of the Council of the Regional Municipality of Halton.
4. That the Town Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to do all things necessary to give effect to this By-law, including giving the required notice.
5. That this by-law, comes into force and takes effect on the day the new council of the Town of Oakville is organized following the regular municipal election in 2018.
6. That notwithstanding paragraph 5 of this by-law, and in accordance with subsection 222(8) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, the regular municipal election scheduled for 2018 shall be conducted as if this by-law was already in force.
7. That By-law 1990-7 is repealed, as of December 1, 2018.

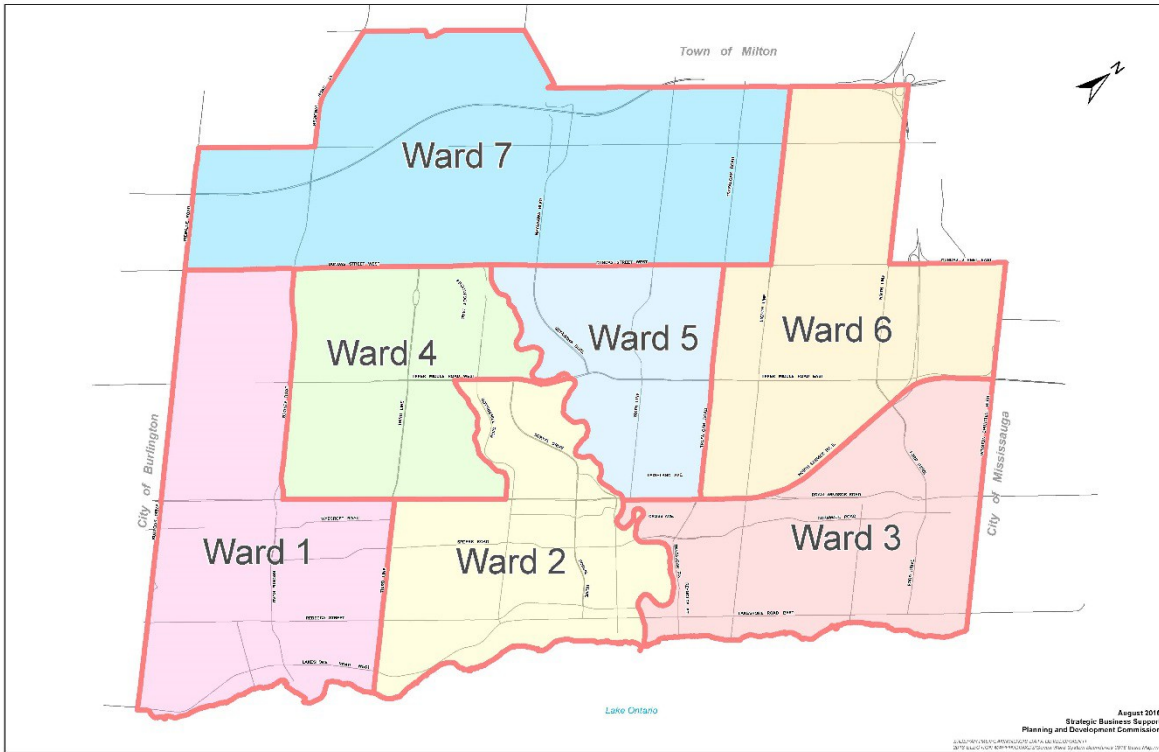

Schedule B to By-law 2016-109

Ward 1 is bounded on the:

- North by Dundas Street, between Burloak Drive and Bronte Road;
- East by Bronte Road, between Dundas Street and the QEW; and by the QEW, between
- Bronte Road and Third Line; and by Third Line, between the QEW and Lake Ontario;
- South by Lake Ontario, between Third Line and Burloak Drive; and,
- West by Burloak Drive, between Lake Ontario and Dundas Street.

Ward 2 is bounded on the:

- North by Upper Middle Road West, between Taplow Creek Trail and Sixteen Mile Creek;
- East by Sixteen Mile Creek, between Upper Middle Road West and Lake Ontario;
- South by Lake Ontario, between Sixteen Mile Creek and Third Line; and,
- West by Third Line, between Lake Ontario and the QEW; and by the QEW, between Third Line and Taplow Creek Trail; and by Taplow Creek Trail, between the QEW and Upper Middle Road West.

Ward 3 is bounded on the:

- North by the QEW, between Sixteen Mile Creek and Winston Churchill Boulevard;
- East by Winston Churchill Boulevard, between the QEW and Lake Ontario;
- South by Lake Ontario, between Winston Churchill Boulevard and Sixteen Mile Creek; and,
- West by Sixteen Mile Creek, between Lake Ontario and the QEW.

Ward 4 is bounded on the:

- North by Dundas Street, between Bronte Road and Sixteen Mile Creek;
- East by Sixteen Mile Creek, between Dundas Street and Upper Middle Road West; and by Upper Middle Road West, between Sixteen Mile Creek and Taplow Creek Trail; and by Taplow Creek Trail, between Upper Middle Road West and the QEW;
- South by the QEW, between Taplow Creek Trail and Bronte Road; and,
- West by Bronte Road, between the QEW and Dundas Street.

Ward 5 is bounded on the:

- North by Dundas Street, between Sixteen Mile Creek and Trafalgar Road;
- East by Trafalgar Road, between Dundas Street and the QEW;
- South by the QEW, between Trafalgar Road and Sixteen Mile Creek, and,
- West by Sixteen Mile Creek, between the QEW and Dundas Street.

Ward 6 is bounded on the:

- North by the northern boundary of the town, between Eighth Line and Ninth Line;
- East by the eastern boundary of the town, between the northern boundary and the QEW;
- South by the QEW, between Winston Churchill Boulevard and Trafalgar Road; and,
- West by Trafalgar Road, between the QEW and Dundas Street; and by Dundas Street, between Trafalgar Road and Eighth Line; and by Eighth Line, between Dundas Street and the northern boundary of the town.

Ward 7 is bounded on the:

- North by the northern boundary of the Town, between Tremaine Road and Eighth Line; East by Eighth Line, between the northern boundary of the town and Dundas Street; South by Dundas Street, between Eighth Line and Tremaine Road; and,
- West by Tremaine Road, between Dundas Street and the northern boundary of the town
