Officiant Preamble, welcome and introduction

THE PURPOSE "We are gathered together to witness the formal joining of and
in legal matrimony according to the custom and law prevailing by the

Officiant to 1st person: Repeat after me please:  "I do solemnly declare that I do not know of any lawful impediment why I,, may not be joined in matrimony to".
Officiant to 2nd person: Repeat after me please:  "I do solemnly declare that I do not know of any lawful impediment why I,, may not be joined in matrimony to".
DECLARATION OF INTENT AND VOWS
" and have chosen to exchange rings today. A ring is a circle without end and just like love is eternal."
"Would you please face each other and repeat after me"
Officiant to 1st person:  "I call upon these persons here present to witness that I, do take you, to be my lawful wedded (wife/husband/partner)"
Please place this ring on the third finger of's left hand saying after me:
"I give you this ring as a symbol of the unending union of my life with yours and as a symbol of my love and commitment to you. With this ring, I thee wed."
Officiant to 2nd person:  "I call upon these persons here present to witness that I, do take you, to be my lawful wedded (wife/husband/partner)"
Please place this ring on the third finger of's left hand saying after me:
"I give you this ring as a symbol of the unending union of my life with yours and as a symbol of my love and commitment to you. With this ring, I thee wed.
As you wear these rings may you find them reminders of an endless love which may grow more meaningful with each passing day.
PRONOUNCEMENT I,, by virtue of the powers vested in me by the <i>Ontario Marriage Act</i> , do hereby pronounce you and
hereby pronounce youand to be (husband and wife, partners in life/married).
CEREMONY CONCLUSION Officiant introduces the married couple.
Now that and have pledged themselves to one another and declared
this by their vows, please allow me to be the first to wish you a long and happy life together. At this time you may share a kiss or embrace as a symbol of your love and commitment.
