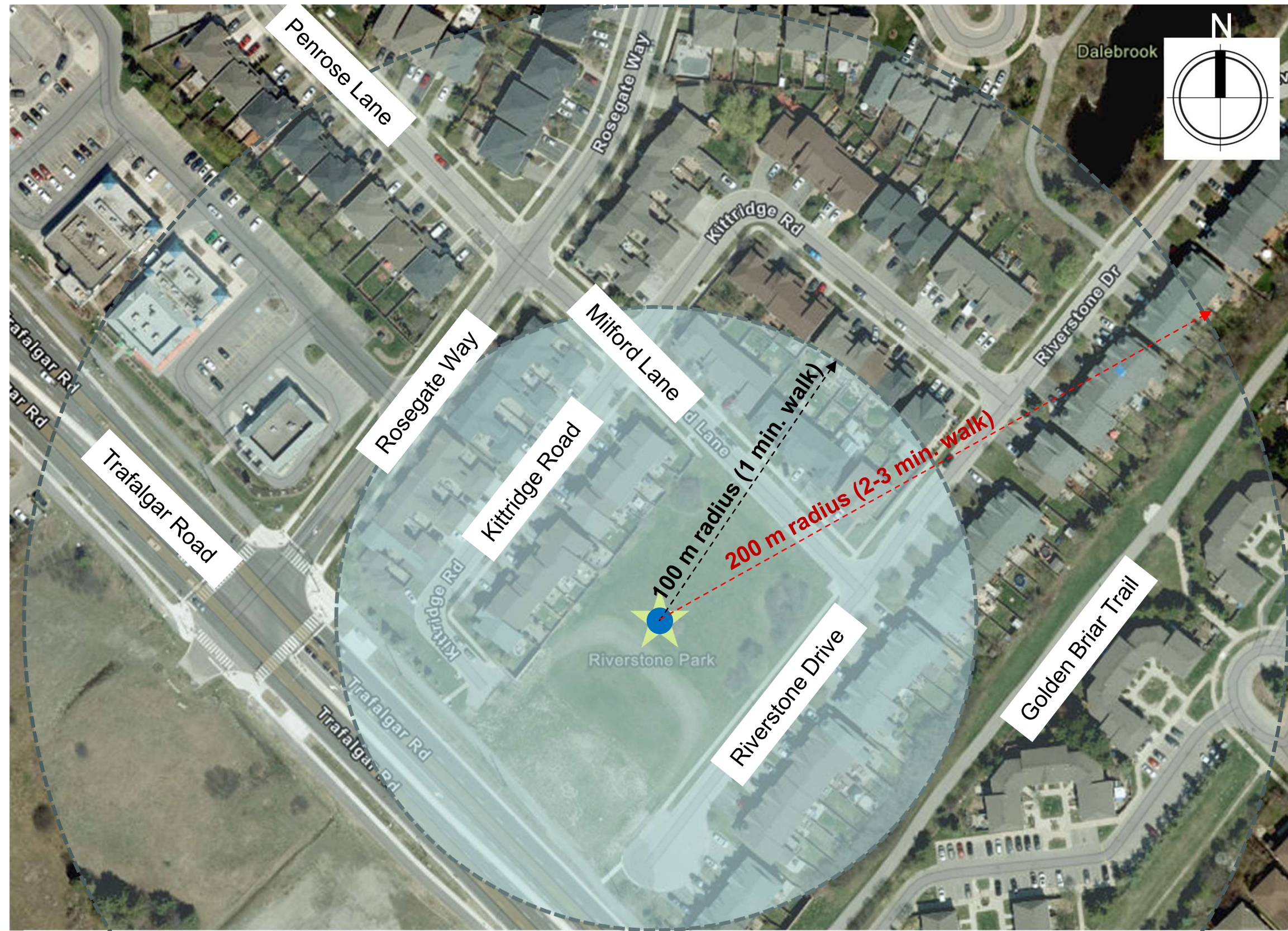

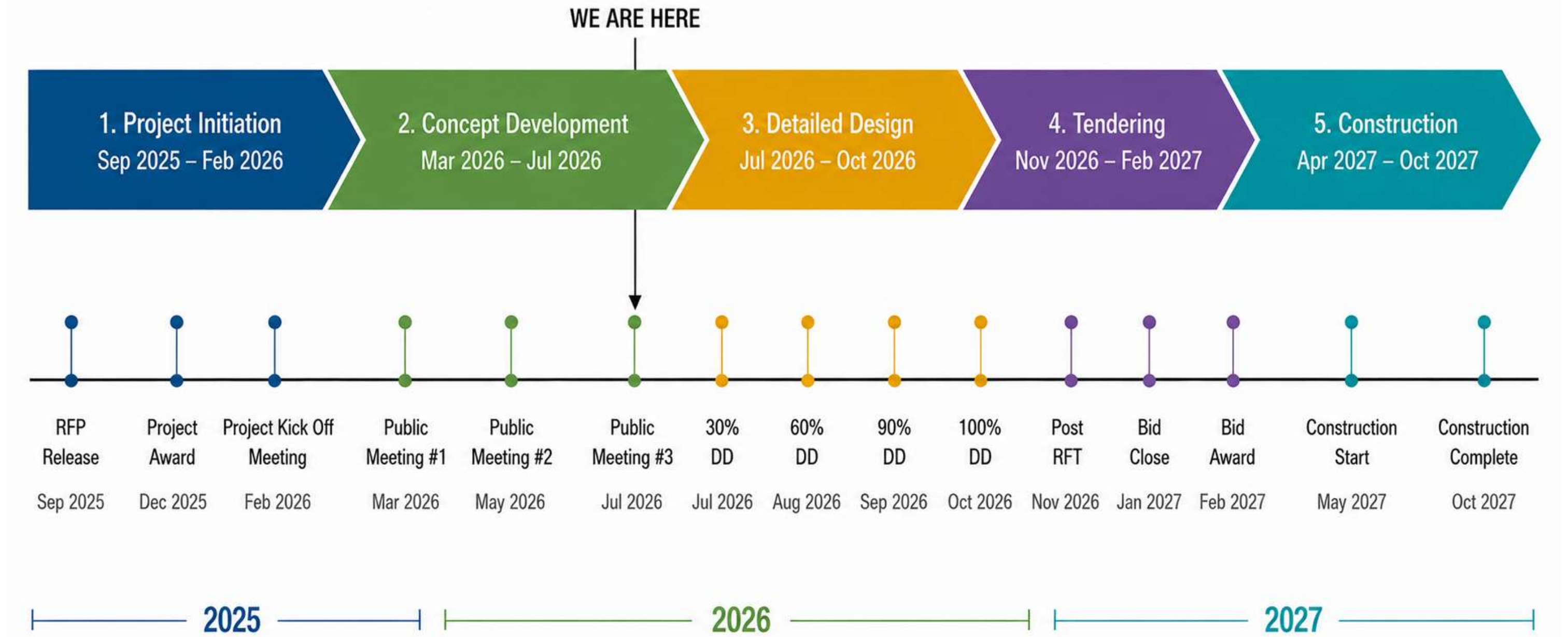

Project Background

- 2273 Trafalgar Road
- 0.65 hectares (1.6 acres) in area
- Former reservoir
- \$2.75M Capital Budget for a Neighbourhood Park



Project Background continued



(Dates subject to change)

May 21 Public Feedback

1. Majority of public preferred Concept 2: Ecological & Systems Landscape as it was more interesting for walking and recreation
2. Refinements included:
 - Preference for segments of chain link fence to close gaps where necessary rather than a continuous run of chain link fence
 - Reduce number of individual games nodes; explore ping pong table
 - Remove multi-use path and replace with sidewalk and sod behind curb
 - Remove misters from fitness station nodes
 - Providing options for sun protection: partial and full shade structures

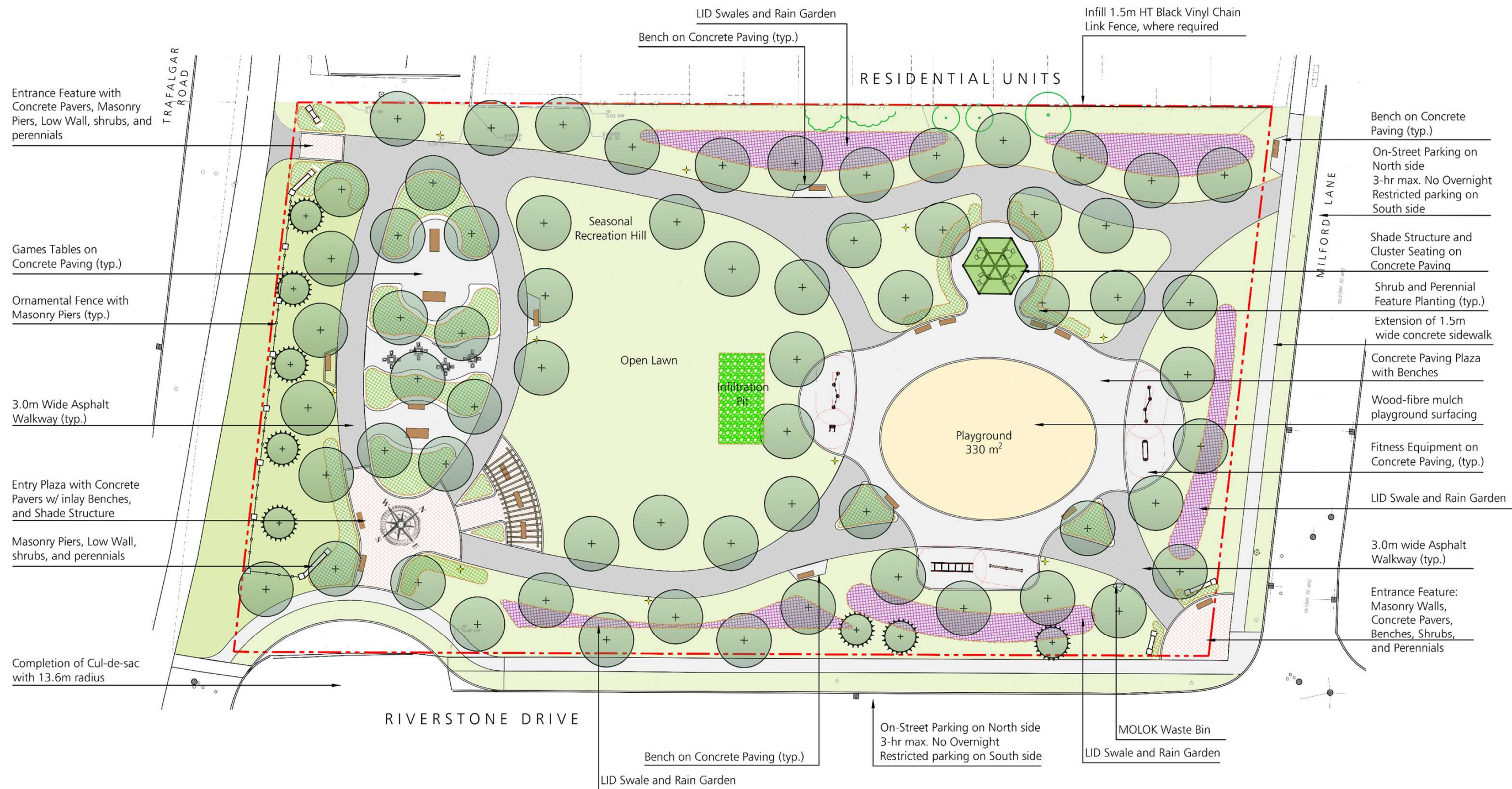

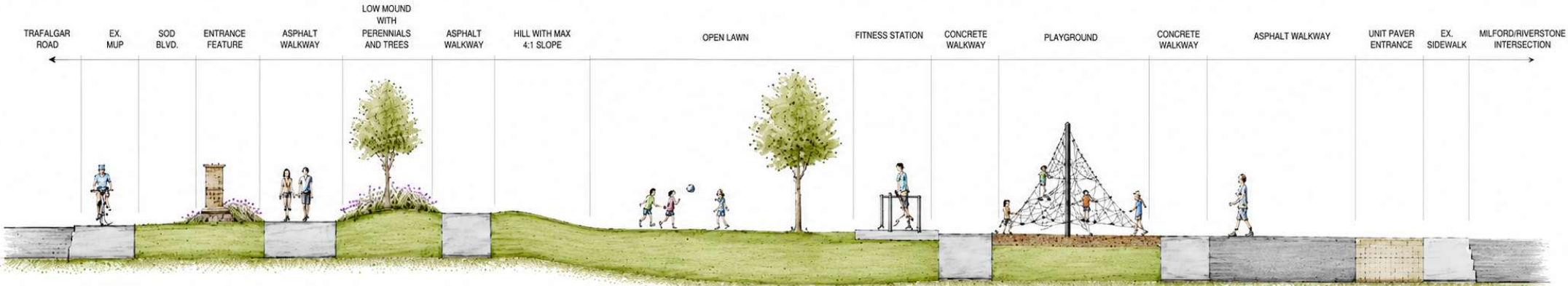

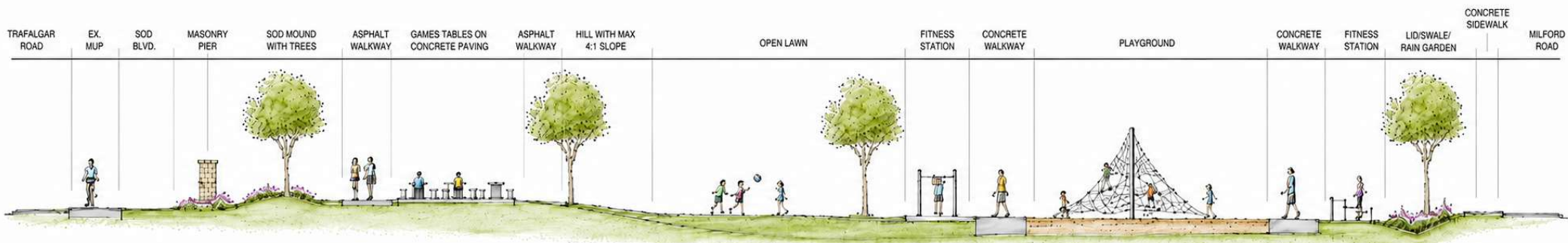
Preferred Concept – Cross Sections



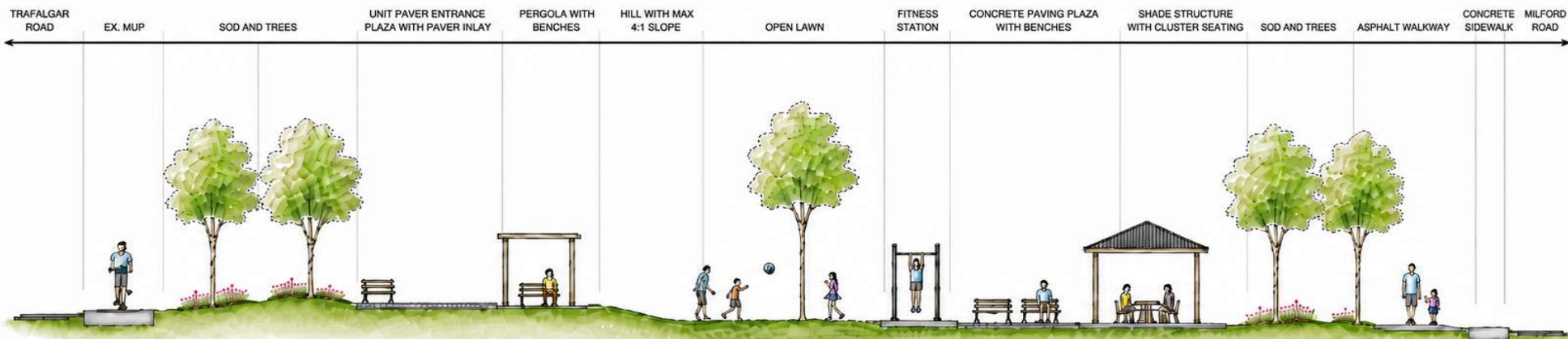

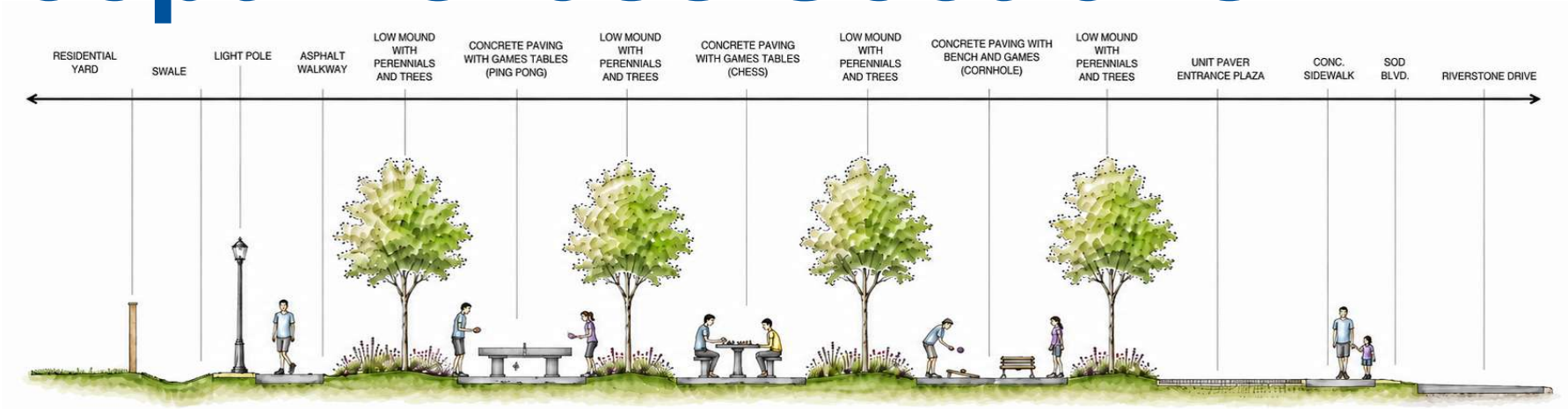

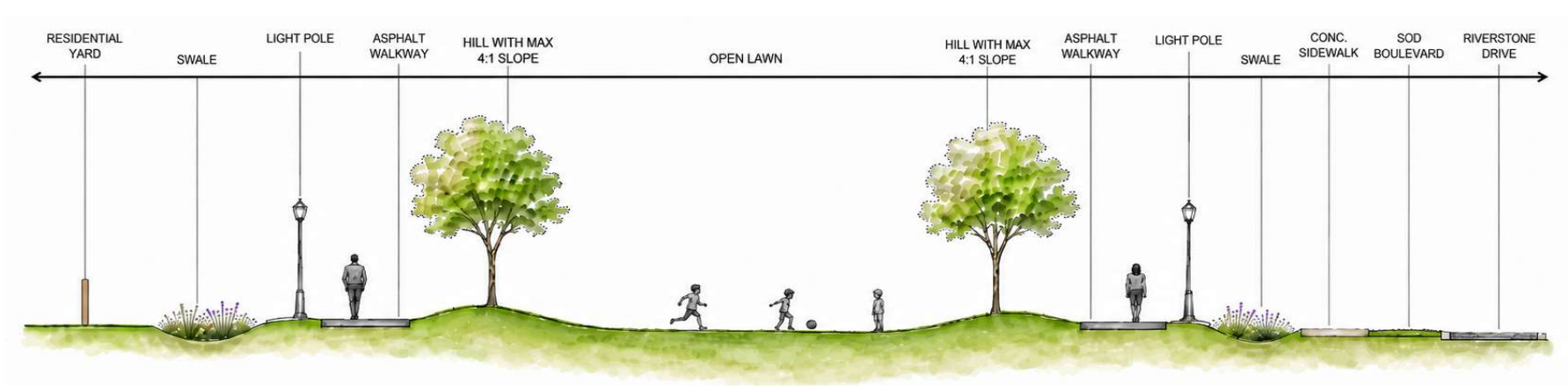

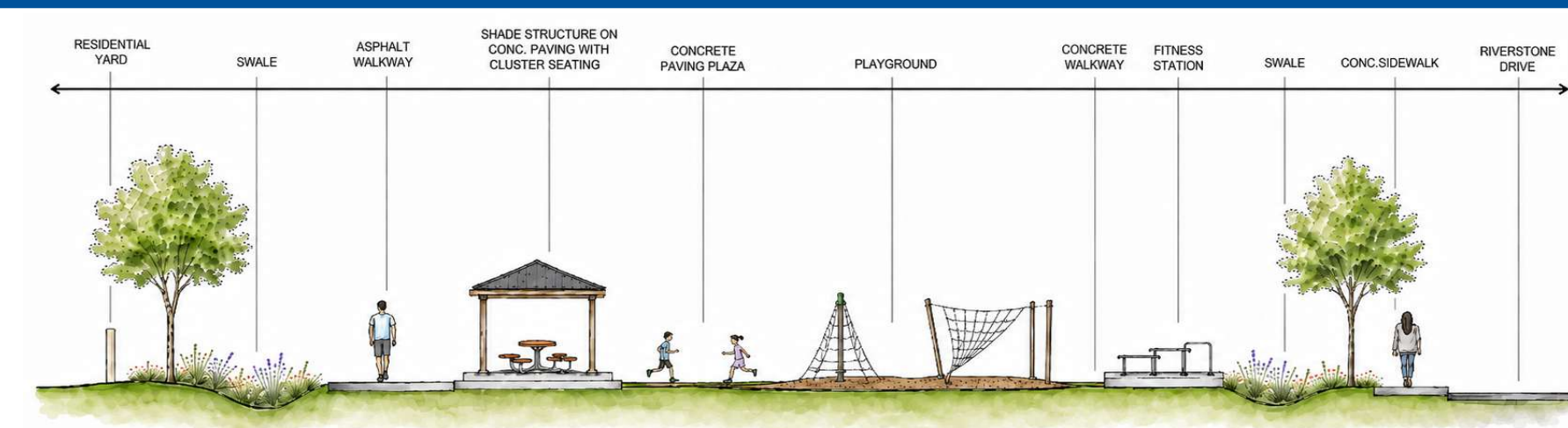

Preferred Concept – Neighbourhood by Nature 'Comfort'



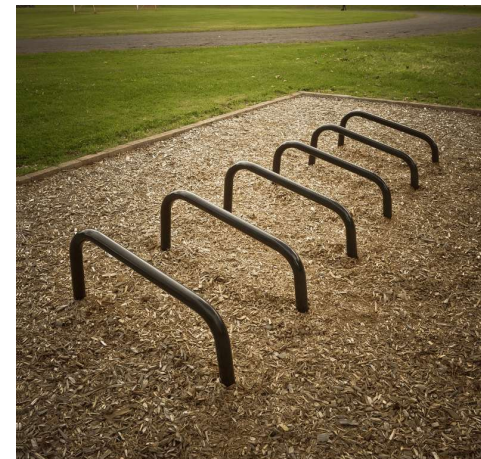
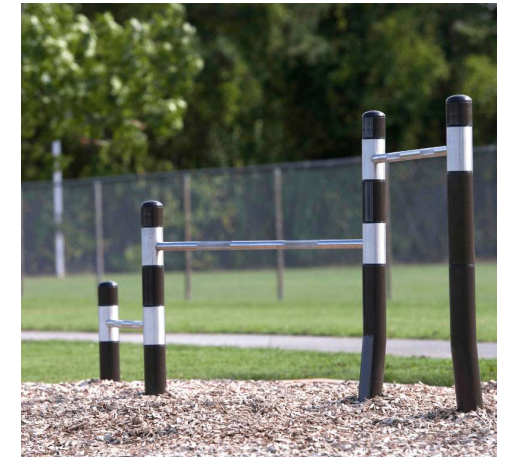
Preferred Concept – Neighbourhood by Nature 'Walkability'



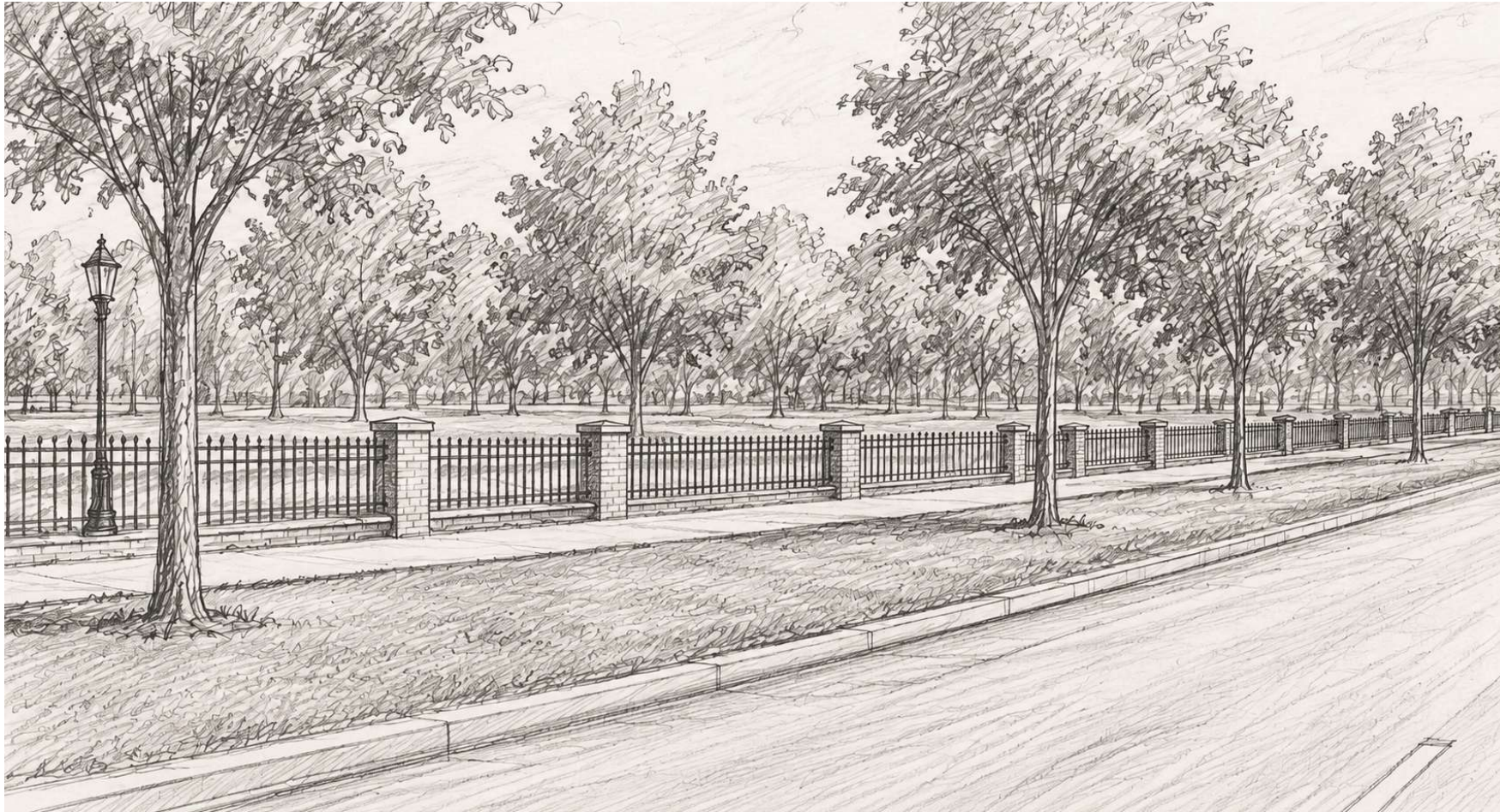
