

## 2024 Commercial Patio Program

## Application for Temporary Encroachment on Municipal Property

The Town of Oakville's Seasonal Commercial Patio Program provides an opportunity for businesses to operate a patio or bistro on municipal property, including on municipal sidewalks and in on-street parking spaces. Anyone wishing to use municipal property to operate a patio, bistro and/or to display merchandise is required to obtain a permit providing a temporary encroachment on municipal property from the Town of Oakville prior to installation.

The 2024 patio season will occur during the period of May 1, 2024 – November 1, 2024.
