XCG Consultants Ltd. (XCG) has completed the review of the Technical Memorandum dated June 10, 2013 prepared by Golder Associates (Golder) entitled "Response to Peer Review – Phase 2 of Complete Application – Bronte Asphalt Plant, Oakville Health Protection Air Quality By-Law Application for Approval" (the Memorandum).

The Memorandum adequately addresses the peer review comments prepared by XCG dated May 21, 2013. The Memorandum provides the requested clarification on several points and includes a revised Land Use zoning Designation plan. No additional modelling or revision of emissions quantified was required in order to address the peer review comments.

Based on the modelling results as presented in the "Oakville Health Protection Air Quality By-Law (HPAQB) Application for Approval dated April 2013 (Version 3)", submitted by Dufferin Construction Company, a division of Holcim (Canada) Inc. (Applicant), for the Bronte Asphalt Plant located at 731 Third Line in Oakville, Ontario (the Facility), the Facility does not significantly affect air quality in the existing airshed, as the facility induced Fine Particulate Matter (FPM) concentrations are less than 0.2 micrograms per cubic metres annually, the criterion defined by the Oakville Health Protection Air Quality By-Law
