Town of Oakville Notice of Master Plan - November 21, 2025 **Completion of Recommended Transportation Master Plan**

The Town of Oakville (Oakville) has completed a Transportation Master Plan (TMP) study that identifies recommended projects, policies, and programs to support walkable, cycle / transit friendly neighbourhoods integrated with accessible transportation choices for all residents. The study establishes a path forward for all modes of transportation to accommodate growth to 2051 and supports Oakville's vision to be a vibrant and livable community for all.

The TMP was completed in accordance with the requirements of Phases 1 and 2 of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (MCEA) process (Municipal Engineers Association, 2023) which is an approved process under the Ontario Environmental Assessment Act. The study followed Master Plan Approach 1 and addresses needs and justification at a broad level. The study evaluated alternative solutions with consideration for the natural, cultural, technical, and economic environment, and recommended preferred solutions in consultation with the public, Indigenous communities, and regulatory agencies.

More detailed studies for each of the recommended projects included in the TMP will be done later following the requirements of the MCEA.
